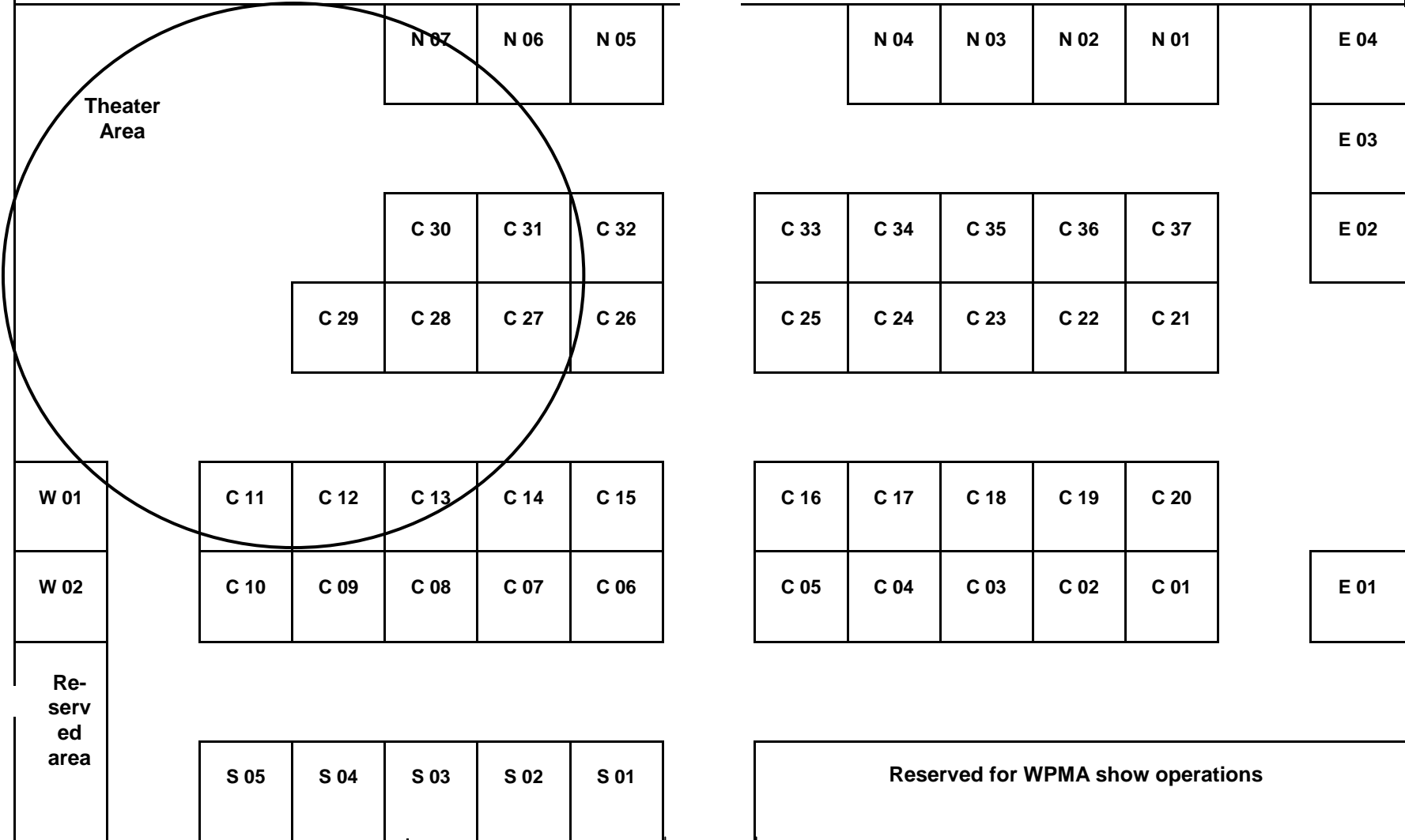

## Price List

- All Booths are 10 feet deep and are available in widths of 10 foot increments up to 40 feet.
- All booths are supplied with One(1) 8 foot table and Two(2) folding chairs for every 10 feet of booth width.
- All "C" booths Backsides are separated by GREEN curtains. "N", "W", "S", & "E" booths walls are bare and are of typical Pole Barn interiors. Vendors are encouraged to bring a backdrop (signs/displays) for these spaces.
- 120 VAC is provided to vendors during the show at no charge
- Vendors are responsible for their own telephone service. Pay telephones are located in the building and at convenient locations throughout the Fairgrounds.

## Additional Information

Smoking is prohibited inside all fairground buildings. Possession of alcoholic beverages, illegal controlled substances, firearms or lethal weapons is prohibited.

A food services contractor has the exclusive right to provide all food, beverages, and similar products (including prepackaged meats, candies and other food and beverage items) on the fairgrounds year-round. Participants cannot sell or distribute these items and are prohibited from contracting with or allowing other parties to sell or distribute these items during the show.

Dogs must be on leash at all times during the show. No other animals are permitted, excluding "assistance animals" as defined by the ADA.

## Lodging & Meals

There is a variety of lodging available in the area around the Evergreen Fairgrounds. However, due to the number of large events held at the fairgrounds, lodging may be difficult to obtain. To insure that you'll be able to make accommodations in the greater Evergreen Fairgrounds area during our **Gold Gem and Mineral Show 2010**, please reserve lodging space as early as possible.

There is RV parking available during the show at \$20/night. Washington Prospectors shall be responsible for collecting RV space rental fees and issuing RV reservation cards to show participants. All RVs parked on the fairgrounds must have a Fairgrounds RV card in the RV's window. RV electrical service consists of one 30A outlet and one 15A outlet. There is no potable water available at RV spaces during winter months. Please ensure your RV arrives with a full water tank. RV holding tank dump stations are located in lots RV-1 and RV-2.

There are a few grocery stores and a large variety of restaurants near the fairgrounds. Due to the location of the fairgrounds to these businesses, plan on using other methods than walking.
